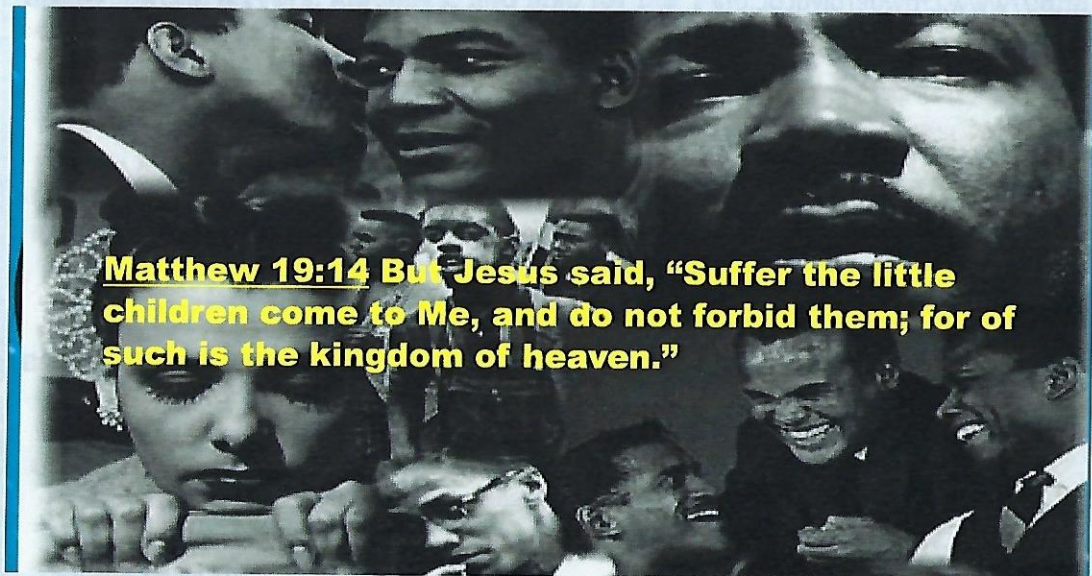

## **Providing For A City Of Children**

**Matthew 19:14** But Jesus said, "Suffer the little children come to Me, and do not forbid them; for of such is the kingdom of heaven."

Our world has become saturated with people destitute of daily food and clothes. About 25,000 people die every day of hunger or hunger-related causes, according to the United Nations. An overwhelming majority of them are children. That's one person every three and a half seconds. In Latin America and Africa, children become addicted to inhalants as they are used as a means to numb the pain from their bodies desperate cries for food. In Cambodia, Haiti and South America, over 2 million girls are trapped in forced prostitution – many die from AIDS before they ever reach 20. Every 14 seconds, a child is orphaned by AIDS in Africa.

Through ministries such as Disaster Relief, Dorcas Day, and our Food Pantry, we have at Crowder tried to make a positive and direct impact on the lives of children in and around the New Orleans area.

**James 1:17** Pure and undefiled religion before God and the Father is this: to visit orphans and widows in their trouble, and to keep oneself unspotted from the world.

The word for "Visit" in this verse means to "look upon in order to help" We are not to live self-focused and self-indulgent lives with a little Christian morality tacked on. We are to pour out our lives for the least of these as a living sacrifice unto our King. I'm so thankful that our church family meeting here loves helping little children. Our supporting ministries such as Dorcas Day Clothing Drive, Vacation Bible School, Disaster Relief and the Food Pantry are just a few tangible ways in which we "suffer the children to come unto Jesus"
